

# Sea to Sky Intergroup

## Qualifications and Responsibilities of World Service Delegate(s) / Regional Representative(s)

**Term of Office:** The term of office shall be not less than three years, or more than 2 consecutive terms, except for reasons to be decided by the Sea to Sky Intergroup.

### **Qualifications for Election:**

- Two years or more membership in the Overeaters Anonymous program.
- Previous service on the Sea to Sky Intergroup Board or attendance at nine of the previous twelve Sea to Sky Intergroup meetings as a meeting representative or committee chairperson.
- Recovering from compulsive overeating and having at least one (1) year of current abstinence at time of election.
- Working the Twelve Step program to the best of his/her ability and having taken the 5<sup>th</sup> Step.
- Present at the election, or having sent a letter indicating willingness and qualifications for this position.
- Shall have at least two (2) years of service above the group level and be able to attend the Region One Assembly and the World Service Conference each year.

### **Responsibilities:**

- a. Shall maintain abstinence while serving as an Elected Board Member.  
While each person is the sole judge of his or her own abstinence, for the purposes of accountability while serving Sea to Sky Intergroup, should a break in abstinence occur, please advise the Chair.
- b. Shall represent Sea to Sky Intergroup at Region I and World Service Business Conference.
- c. Shall obtain input from Sea to Sky Intergroup regarding World Service Business Conference agenda three months prior to the World Business Conference.
- d. Shall work together with Alternate Delegate(s) and visit each meeting at least once a year.
- e. Shall be available to help groups in terms of upholding the 12 Traditions and the 12 Concepts.
- f. Shall act as custodian for World Service Handbook and Assembly Handbook.
- g. Shall provide regular reports to Sea to Sky Intergroup regarding Region I and WSO activities.
- h. Shall report at the Sea to Sky Intergroup meeting immediately following any travel and participation on behalf of Sea to Sky Intergroup.
